March 29, 2015 Notes:

1. God the Father's Ultimate Security Clearance (or, Unique Authority)
 - a. Acts 1:7 – "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority."
 - b. Zechariah 14:7 – "a day known only to the LORD."
2. Son of God does NOT know
 - a. Matthew 24:36 and Mark 13:32
 - i. "That day" is the day of Jesus' Parousia
 1. Mt. 7:22 – Jesus appears as the JUDGE on that Day
 2. It is the OT Day of the Lord
 3. Mt. 25:31-34 Jesus sits on a throne in glory to judge the nations on that Day
 - ii. "No one knows" means absolutely NO human knows this information
 - iii. "angels" do not know
 1. Yet, they do have access to hidden information in scrolls/books that they reveal to Daniel
 2. 1 Peter 1:12, angels long to look into these things
 - iv. "The Son" does not know
 1. This does not refer to him as a human (part of the kenosis theory of Christology, which I agree with). If this referred to Jesus as a man it would say "Son of Man" does not know
 2. This is a reference to his position as the Son of God, the second member of the Trinity.
 3. "Son" in this abbreviated form refers to the second member of the Trinity, the Son of God (not the Son of Man) in:
 - a. Matthew 28:19 in the Trinitarian formula for baptism and allegiance to the Son of God
 - b. Matthew 11:27 – Jesus, the Son, unique relationship to the Father.
 4. John 14:28 – The Father is greater than Jesus
 5. John 20:23 – (same)
 6. Yet, John 10:30, "I and the Father are one", maintains Jesus divinity
 7. John 5:19-23 – READ
 8. John 8:28 – "I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me.
 - v. "Only the Father knows" is very explicit
 - vi. The Son of God has a central role, but he does not know.

 4. Revelation 5:1-6:1
