

1. Jeremiah 26:7-24 – Jeremiah is accused of betraying temple and nation.
 2. Jeremiah 27:1-21 – Jeremiah says submit to Babylon.
 3. Jeremiah 28:1-17 – False prophet Hananiah counters Jeremiah's prophecy.
- Sadducees and Pharisees Civil War before Roman General Pompey takes Jerusalem in **63 BC**.
 - Civil war between two Hasmonean brothers Hyrcanus (Pharisee, advised by Antipater the Idumean) and Aristobulus (Sadducee)
 - Jewish sects Civil War before Roman invasion during Jewish war with Rome **66-70 AD**

Wisdom

- When to cooperate? When to resist?
- What is the issue
- Where is compromise acceptable, necessary or impossible, wrong

Do what is right – 1 Peter 2:13-25

World (kosmos)

- Divided among itself by nature (Gal. 5; Woman/Beast/Nations;
- Opposes God and his Christ (Ps. 2)
- Kingdom of its own without Christ
- Deceived by Satan (Satan is god of this age; bound up to deceive the nations no more)

1. Cooperated with Babylon and Persia

Jesus

1. Confronted the Priests – John 1:19-24
2. Cooperated with Pilate – John 18:28-40
3. Refused to speak to Herod – Luke 23:6-12 (Luke 22:66-23:25)
4. Prophesied to the population – Luke 23:26-31
5. Ignored the mockers and Promised the thief salvation – Luke 23:32-40
6. Took care of human responsibilities – John 19:25-27
7. Fulfilled his personal ministry mission – John 19:28-30
