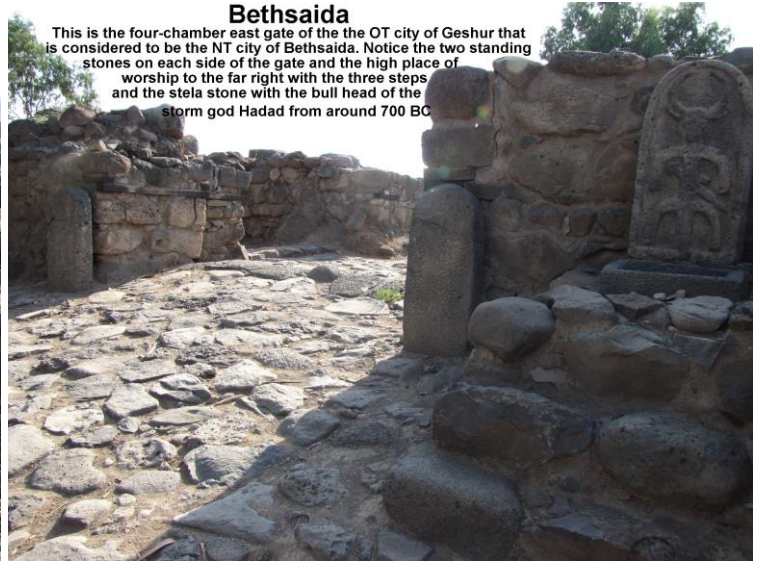
Bethsaida

Bethsaida

This is the four-chamber east gate of the the OT city of Geshur that is considered to be the NT city of Bethsaida. Notice the two standing stones on each side of the gate and the high place of worship to the far right with the three steps and the stela stone with the bull head of the storm god Hadad from around 700 BC

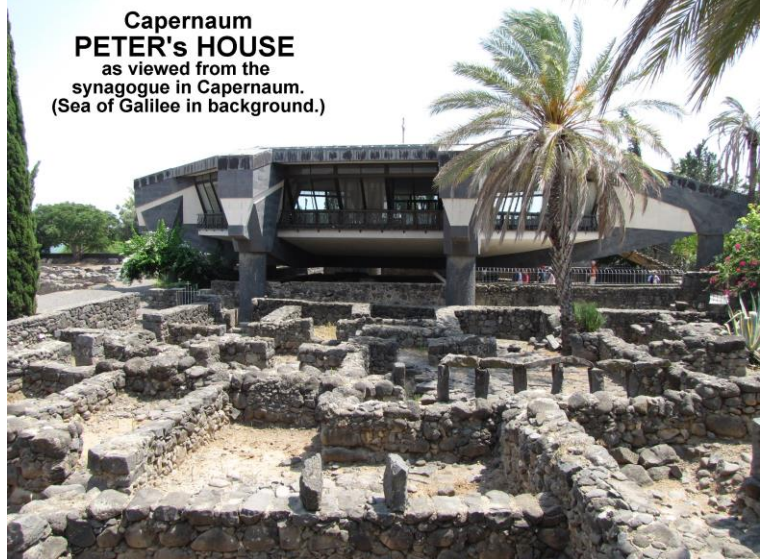

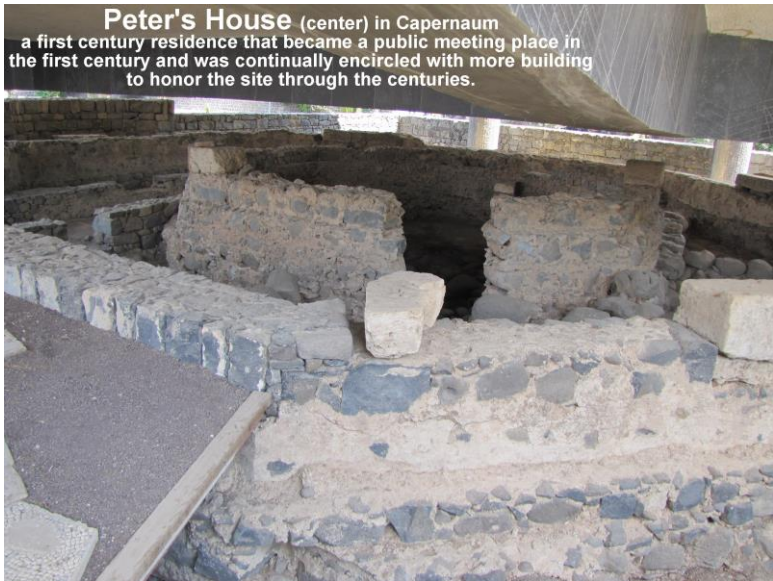
