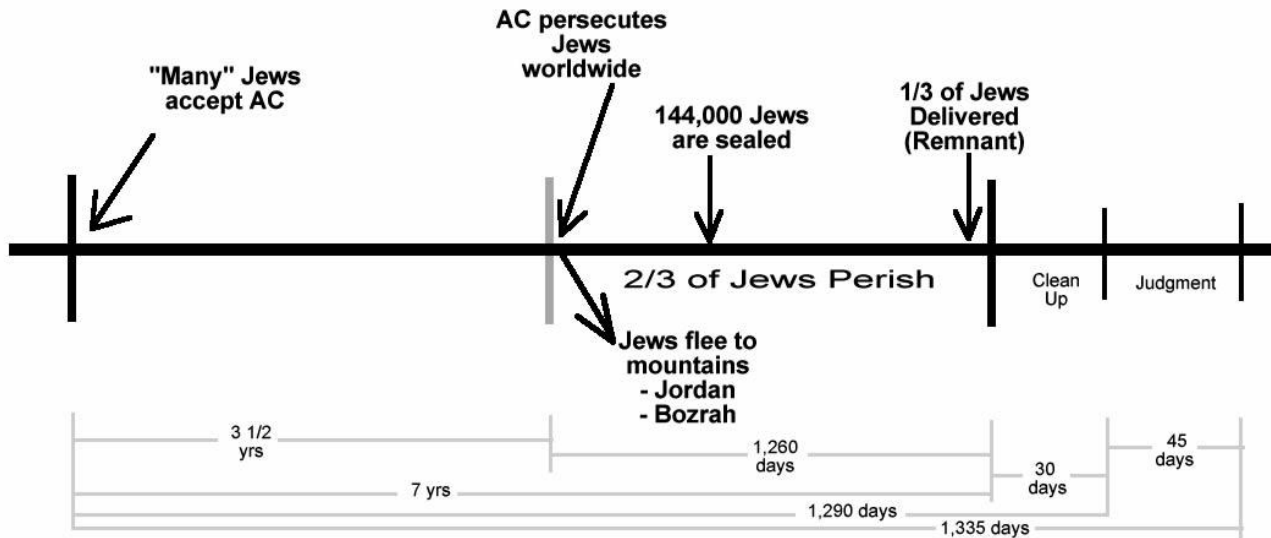


## The 75 Days between 1,260 and 1,335 (30+45 days)



- a. Abomination of Desolation is removed after 1,290 days in **Daniel 12:11** -  
*"from the time that the regular burnt offering is taken away and the abomination that makes desolate is set up, there shall be 1,290 days."*
- b. Jesus' judgment of nations is completed in the Kidron after 1,335 days (+45 days) in **Daniel 12:12** -  
*"Blessed is he who waits and arrives at the 1,335 days. But go your way till the end. And you shall rest and shall stand in your allotted place at the end of the days."*

### Events During the 75 Days (1,260-1,335) (30 Days+45 Days)

1. Removal of the Abomination of Desolation from the Temple – Daniel 12:11
2. Antichrist
  - a. Killed at return of Jesus:  
*"Then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus will kill with the breath of his mouth and bring to nothing by the appearance of his coming." – 2 Thessalonians 2:8*
  - b. Apparently resurrected, which is the beginning of the Second Resurrection.
    - i. The First Resurrection began with the resurrection of Jesus Christ
    - ii. The First Resurrection continues in waves including the two witnesses, the rapture of the church and the martyred tribulation saints
    - iii. The Second Resurrection begins with the resurrection of the anti-christ (first beast) and continues until the resurrection for the Great White Throne judgment.
      1. Revelation 20:11-15 – The Great White Throne Judgment
  - c. Then, cast alive into the Lake of Fire:  
*"The beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who in its presence[e] had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur." – Revelation 19:20*
3. False Prophet killed, resurrected and sent to Lake of Fire (Rev. 19:20)
4. Satan is sent into the Abyss for 1,000 years
  - a. Revelation 20:1-3
  - b. This is Satan's fifth area to be assigned to.
  - c. The "Six Abodes of Satan"

- i. The Throne of God (Ezekiel 28:11-15)
  - ii. The Garden of Eden (Ez. 28:16-17; Isaiah 14:12-19)
  - iii. The Atmospheric Heavens (The Air; The Atmosphere; The Sky) (Ephesians 2:2; 6:12) with access to Earth (Job 1:6; 2:1; Rev. 12:10; Zech. 3:1; John 12:31; 2 Cor. 4:4; Luke 4:5-7; 1 Peter 5:8; 1 Cor. 11:14)
  - iv. The Earth (Rev. 12:7-12)
  - v. The Abyss (Rev. 20:1-3)
  - vi. The Lake of Fire ((Rev. 20:7-10)
- 5. Judgment of Gentiles
  - a. Joel 3:1-3
  - b. Matthew 25:31-45
- 6. Resurrection of the Old Testament Saints
  - a. Isaiah 26:19:
 

*“Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise.  
You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for joy!  
For your dew is a dew of light,  
and the earth will give birth to the dead.”*
  - b. Daniel 12:2:
 

**“And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life (OT believers as part of the First Resurrection), and some to shame and everlasting contempt (Unbelievers as part of the Second Resurrection at the Great White Throne).”**
- 7. Resurrection of the Martyred Tribulation Saints
  - a. Rev. 20:4-6
 

*“Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is **the first resurrection**. Blessed and holy is the one who shares in **the first resurrection**! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.”*
- 8. Marriage Feast of the Lamb
  - a. Revelation 19:9 – *“And the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.” And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.” (Rev. 19:6-10)*
  - b. John 3:29 – *“The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete.”*
  - c. Matthew 22:1-14
  - d. Matthew 25:1-13

# The First Resurrection

“But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own **order**: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.” – 1 Corinthians 15:20-23

**Ταγμα** “*tagma*” translated as “in turn” also means “rank”, “order”.

- This word is a technical military term referring to a division of troops that can be released into battle at the commander’s orders.
- It can be used to refer to any sort of group while referring to the place, or their position besides their sequence in order or rank.
- “In the New Testament, “tagma” refers to an arrangement or a specific order, often used in a military or hierarchical context. It implies a structured sequence or a designated position within a larger framework. The term is used to describe an orderly arrangement, such as ranks in an army or a sequence of events.” -Bible Hub

## The order of the First Resurrection:

1. Jesus
2. Church
3. Two Witnesses
4. Old Testament Saints
5. Tribulation Saints



a. **Zechariah 14:1-5 (4-5) -**

*“Behold, a day is coming for the Lord, when the spoil taken from you will be divided in your midst. For I will gather all the nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city shall be taken and the houses plundered and the women raped. Half of the city shall go out into exile, but the rest of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then the Lord will go out and fight against those nations as when he fights on a day of battle.*

*On that day his feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives that lies before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall*

*be split in two from east to west by a very wide valley, so that one half of the Mount shall move northward, and the other half southward. And you shall flee to the valley of my mountains, for the valley of the mountains shall reach to Azal. And you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the Lord my God will come, and all the holy ones with him”*

b. **Joel 3:12-17 –**

*“Let the nations stir themselves up and come up to the Valley of Jehoshaphat;”  
Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe.*

*Go in, tread, for the winepress is full. The vats overflow, for their evil is great.  
Multitudes, multitudes, in the valley of decision!*

*For the day of the Lord is near in the valley of decision.*

*The sun and the moon are darkened, and the stars withdraw their shining.*

*The Lord roars from Zion, and utters his voice from Jerusalem, and the heavens and the earth quake.*

*But the Lord is a refuge to his people, stronghold to the people of Israel.”*

c. **Matthew 25:31-34 (25:31-46) –**

*“When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.’”*
