



••• The persecution of the Jerusalem believers in 35 AD by Saul and the Sanhedrin caused the believers to flee from Jerusalem to the island of Cyprus, the land of Phoenicia and the city of Antioch in Syria. They shared the gospel only with the Jews. (Acts 11:19)

 — Men from the African city of Cyrene and the island of Cyprus went to Antioch and shared the gospel not only with Jewish people, but also with the Gentiles.



- 35-38 AD, Paul is converted near Damascus & spends time in Arabia, the Nabatean kingdom that extends from Damascus to the Red Sea (Gal. 1:17).
- 38 AD, After a year or two, Paul returns to Damascus & preaches in synagogues. Paul escapes Damascus & leaves for Jerusalem.
- 3. 38 AD, Paul returns to Jerusalem after having been gone for 3 years.Paul spends fifteen days with Peter and meets James (Gal.1:18-19). Paul debates the Grecian Jews and his life is threatened (Acts 9:29).
- 38 AD, Paul escapes Jerusalem and is taken to Caesarea to board a ship for his hometown of Tarsus in Cilicia (Acts 9:30).
- 5. 38-43 AD, Paul preaches in Cilicia and Syria for five years (Gal.1:20-23).
- 6. 43 AD, Barnabus leaves Antioch to search for Paul in Tarsus in order to bring him back to teach in the church of Antioch.
- 44 AD, After one year of preaching in Antioch (Acts 11:26), Paul goes with Barnabus to Jerusalem with an offering from the Antioch church for the believers suffering from the famine (Acts 11:29-30). While they are there James is killed by Herod Agrippa I, Peter escapes from prison and Herod Agrippa I dies in Caesarea (Acts 12).
- 8. 45 AD, Barnabas and Saul return from Jerusalem to Antioch. John Mark comes with them (Acts 12:25).




