

Genesis 22:20-24 and Genesis 23:1-20

Genesis 22::20 – Now after these things it was told to Abraham, "Behold, Milcah also has borne children to your brother Nahor:

- 22:21 Uz his firstborn, Buz his brother, Kemuel the father of Aram,
- 22:22 Chesed, Hazo, Pildash, Jidlaph, and Bethuel."
- 22:23 (Bethuel fathered Rebekah.) These eight Milcah bore to Nahor, Abraham's brother.
- 22:24 Moreover, his concubine, whose name was Reumah, bore Tebah, Gaham, Tahash, and Maacah.





Genesis 11:27-32 - **Now these are the generations of Terah. Terah fathered <u>Abram, Nahor,</u> and <u>Haran;</u> and Haran fathered Lot.**

- 28 Haran died in the presence of his father Terah in the land of his kindred, in Ur of the Chaldeans.
- 29 And Abram and Nahor took wives. The name of Abram's wife was <u>Sarai</u>, and the name of Nahor's wife, <u>Milcah</u>, the daughter of Haran the father of <u>Milcah</u> and <u>Iscah</u>.
- 30 Now Sarai was barren; she had no child.
- 31 Terah took Abram his son and Lot the son of Haran, his grandson, and Sarai his daughter-in-law, his son Abram's wife, and they went forth together from Ur of the Chaldeans to go into the land of Canaan, but when they came to Haran, they settled there.
- 32 The days of Terah were 205 years, and Terah died in Haran.
 - 1. Genesis 22:1-19 is the climax in the life of Abraham and Sarah
 - 2. Genesis 22:20-24 Isaac and Rebekah's Family Background
 - a. records the transition from Abraham to Isaac by presenting the family background of Rebekah who became Isaac's wife.
 - b. the preparation for the succession of the patriarchs
 - i. Isaac succeeding Abraham
 - ii. Rebekah succeeding Sarah.
 - 3. Genesis 22:20 begins the third and final section of the sixth book in Genesis.

For this information to reach Abraham it had to take a seven hundred mile journey from northnortheast of Beersheba

BOOK #6 has three sections:

- 1. Introduction (11:27b-32)
- 2. Main body (12:1-22:19)
- 3. Transition to the next section of the book of Genesis and generation (22:20-25:11).
 - a. Genesis 22:20 begins the **3RD SECTION** of the **6TH BOOK**, which can be divided upon into five scenes:
 - i. Genesis 22:20-24 containing the genealogy of Nahor, including Rebekah.
 - ii. Genesis 23:1-20, which provides the account of the death of Sarah and Abraham securing real estate in the land of Canaan.
 - iii. Genesis 24:1-67 recording Abraham securing a bride for the son of promise Isaac.
 - iv. Genesis 25:1-6 containing the genealogy of Abraham through Keturah.
 - v. Genesis 25:7-11, which records the death of Abraham.

This **3RD SECTION** in the **6TH BOOK** in Genesis prepares the reader for a shift:

- from Abraham's leadership to → Isaac's
- from Sarah to → Rebekah.
