- 2. Joseph, the fourth generation, knew they were going to fulfill the Abrahamic Covenant because he had faith in God
- 3. In Avaris a Semitic dignitary from 1700 BC was found with a ruler stick across his chest. The statue was found crushed inside a tomb twice human size wearing a striped garment with at least 3 colors and was decorated as Egyptians decorate Semitic people
